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ON COVER – An outcrop located in the Lianyuan sag in the middle of the Yangtze Platform in South China. The stratum is the Carboniferous Ceshui Formation (C₁d²). The main lithology of the stratum is gray-white fine sandstone and siltstone, with gray thin mudstone and multiple layers coal with thickness approximately 5–20 cm (~2–8 in.).
